Stage 2: Competency Learning Map: ¹

- Core topics designated by Cisco (e.g. *Secure Firewall, Duo, Umbrella*)
- 3 Additional product electives you choose, with quizzes for all.

Stage 3: Architecture Messaging (Live Demo/s & POV Lab):

- Two-day workshop and validation to apply Stages 1 & 2 in customer scenarios.
- Complete a SAFE pitch and product demo(s) for the Core and Elective products selected.
- Provide Proof of Performance (PoP) and/or reports from the POV labs required.

Fire Jumper:

- Upon successful completion of Stages 1, 2 and 3, you will earn a Fire Jumper certificate. You can submit that Fire Jumper certificate to Black Belt to earn Black Belt accreditation.

Fire Jumper Elite: *(optional)*

- Elite status represents the upper echelon of Fire Jumpers, since Elites have mastered foundational training on all products in the Cisco security portfolio. Elites also earn program completion rewards and additional perks.

Stage 3: Workshop & Lab
